What is Character Council?

Character council at North Bend Elementary School is made up of students from the 4th and 5th-grade classes. All students in 4th and 5th grade have an opportunity to be on Character Council. Character Council members model positive behaviors and good character for other students and must follow school rules.

Character Council Responsibilities

- Plan character-related activities
- Promote good character school-wide
- Be a strong positive role model
- Help mentor younger students
- Be new student ambassadors
- Weekly recycling pick-up
- Help with K-3 track meet at the end of the year
- Counting bracelets and helping with Box Tops

How do students become a Character Council Member?

Students from 4th and 5th grade will complete a written questionnaire regarding their good character, positive behaviors, and reasons for wanting to be on Character Council. These questions will be answered on the questionnaire provided and returned back to Miss Mann. After completing the interview questions, students will be handed two evaluations that they will be responsible for having their teacher from the previous year and another staff member complete and return back to Miss Mann. All students will be considered to be a part of Character Council.

When does Character Council meet?

Character Council will meet twice a month on Thursdays at 7:50 am in Miss Mann's room. A monthly schedule will be provided. Dates are subject to change, a notice will be given in advance.
